Group Exhibition at SKOL

May 1 to June 21, 2025 — Opening Reception on Thursday, May 1 at 5 p.m.

MONTREAL, MONDAY, APRIL 28, 2025 — The Centre des arts actuels SKOL presents *Beneath the Surface of the Everyday*, a group exhibition bringing together five emerging artists: **Zoé Julien-Tessier, Annie-Kim Rainville, Alejandra Zamudio, Sarah Toung ondo, and Amanda Roy**. Curated by Félipe Goulet-Letarte and Adrien Guillet, this exhibition features works developed during creative residencies at Centre SAGAMIE, exploring textile printing, micro-publishing, archival appropriation, and graphic narratives.

Through sensitive and committed gestures, the artists reveal the invisible stories and subtle presences that weave through our daily lives. From commemorative textiles and intimate micro-publications to immersive drawings and archival reinterpretations, *Beneath the Surface of the Everyday* invites viewers to slow down and discover perspectives often overlooked by dominant narratives.

The exhibition text is written by author Gabrielle Izaguirré-Falardeau, extending this exploration of inner worlds and quiet forms of resistance.
