ABOUT THE OPPORTUNITY

SKOL is seeking an emerging graphic designer based in Montréal to imagine and develop the visual identity for SKOL's 2026-2027 season on communities of care.

This is a paid mentorship opportunity. SKOL will offer a flat fee of \$3,000 CAD to the selected emerging designer and provide a professional support framework throughout the creative process, in collaboration with a graphic design studio.

We are looking for a fresh and experimental approach to support the visual identity of the upcoming exhibition.

DIGITAL DELIVERABLES

- One poster for the 2027 season
- Four exhibition posters (one per exhibition)
- Four booklets (a common template already designed to be adapted for each exhibition)
- Exhibition signage

GRAPHIC DESIGN

- The selected graphic designer will be asked to propose:
- A unified visual identity for the season, adapted for each exhibition; or
- Four distinct visual themes, one for each exhibition, while ensuring visual consistency and the overall sustainability of the project.
- The approach sought must be original and experimental.



TIMELINE

- **June 1st (noon):** submission deadline
- **End of June:** start of employment
- **Mid-August:** delivery of first deliverables (for the launch)
- **End of August:** public launch of SKOL's 2026–2027 season

ELIGIBILITY

- Be a freelance graphic designer early in your career
- Be based in Montreal
